Meander through 2.2 acres of a "museum of living plants" using a FREE map in a remarkable garden started by Arnold D. Haskell in 1955. Stroll through a diverse mix of colors to tempt the eyes. Ramble along brick walkways, past free flowing fountains, animal sculptures and beneath arbors and palm trees. Step inside the humid Tropical Conservatory for a peak at some gloriously blooming orchids or ginger and feel like you are on a wild Pacific island. Don't miss the koi hiding in the greenery of the pond. Check out the Rose, Japanese, Fern Grotto, Sun, Herb, Cactus and Succulent gardens. Reach down and touch the chocolate mint or society garlic in the Herb Garden to get a burst of fragrance. The garden is part of the Sherman Library Complex, but can be enjoyed separately or as a nice stimulating break from your research.
